Carnival Floats Safety Regulations

1. The vehicle and any trailer forming part of the float must comply with Section 40 of the Road Traffic Act 1988.
2. The vehicle or trailer must be mechanically sound and not suffering from any corrosion or defect that is likely to lead to a failure. Any float or equipment carried on the vehicle or trailer should be secured and be substantial enough for the job for which it is intended.
3. The vehicle or trailer must be suitable for the job which it is intended. i.e.; you can not pull a ten ton trailer with a Land Rover 90 Series, because the vehicle was not designed for that purpose nor are the breaks capable of stopping such a load.
4. You can not carry more people than the vehicle was designed for. Passengers carried on an open vehicle or trailer may fall off or injure themselves, therefore passengers must not be in such a position where their safety is compromised whatsoever.
5. Anything carried or bolted to the vehicle or trailer, must be safe and remain safe throughout the procession.
6. The vehicle or trailer, the load or passengers must not be in any way likely to cause injury to any person carried in or on the vehicle or in the proximity of the vehicle whilst it is on a public road. You will be criminally liable in civil law if any injury is sustained whatsoever.
7. A certificate of insurance or suitable indemnity must be in force covering the use of the vehicle and float in the carnival procession.
8. No passengers may be carried on a carnival float unless it is in the Carnival procession.
9. Any such procession may only proceed at walking pace when passengers are carried on the float. Each float must be under the supervision of a suitable person(s) who will walk along side the float.
10. A means of communication must be available between the driver and the passengers on the float to halt the vehicle immediately should the need arise.
11. No one will climb off or on the vehicle or trailer whilst in the procession, unless the vehicle is stationary and one of the float supervisors is in contact with the driver who will be told once it is safe to proceed.
12. Under no circumstances will the consumption of alcohol be allowed by any driver, or other person carried in or on the carnival float or any one supervising the float on foot.
13. The tow bar will be supervised at all times to ensure that no one crosses the vehicles or rides the tow bar.
14. Children and adults should be seated and must be provided with hand holds if standing.
15. Failure to abide by the Safety Regulations will result in exclusion from the carnival procession by the police or a Carnival Committee member.
